

Cookies Policy

In Begis 2002, S.L. (hereinafter, Begis 2002) we use cookies in order to provide a better service and a better browsing experience. We want to inform you in a clear, transparent and concise way about the cookies we use, detailing below what cookies are, what they are for, what types of cookies we use, what their purpose are and how you can configure or disable them if you wish.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

A cookie is a small file downloaded to your computer, mobile device (smartphone, tablet, etc.) or any other gadget with navigation information, when accessing web files or mobile applications. Cookies allow a web page, among other things, to save and retrieve Internet log information and visitor behaviour information and, depending on the information they contain and the way you use your device, they can be used to recognize the user.

The set of cookies of our users helps us to improve the quality of our website, allowing us to control which pages are useful, which are not, and which are susceptible to improvement. Cookies are essential for the operation of the internet, providing countless advantages in the provision of interactive services, facilitating the navigation and usability of our website. Under no circumstances cookies may damage your computer or mobile device.

Cookies do not identify you personally and do not pose any risk to your computer or mobile device, hence they are not viruses or spyware. They are tools used by the websites you visit to improve your browsing, so that your data travels through the network safe, to help us understand what information on our website is more useful for our users or to know what offers may be of interest to us. All this is being held in a totally anonymous way: we will never know your name, address or phone number, unless you provide them to us. You decide whether or not you install our cookies.

In addition, you should keep in mind that, if you decide not to allow the use of cookies, some features of the website may not work properly and, further, we will not be able to adapt the information we offer to your interests. In any case can the non-acceptance of cookies mean that you cannot access and use the basic functions of our website.

We also want to inform you that, in application of European and Spanish regulations regarding privacy and cookies, there are cookies that require user consent (e.g., analysis or measurement cookies and behavioural advertising cookies), and others that are free of consent (e.g., technical cookies or those necessary for the provision of services specifically requested by the user).

THE DATA CONTROLLER

The cookies used in www.begis.net are processed by Begis 2002, S.L. (Begis 2002) with the purposes and storage times set out in the section "Cookies we use".

WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES DO WE USE?

Depending on who they are managed by, there are:

- **First-party cookies**, which are sent to the user's computer from a computer or domain managed by the publisher from which the service requested by the user is provided.

- **Third-party cookies**, which are sent to the user's computer from a computer or domain that is not managed by the publisher, but by a third party, which processes the data obtained via the cookies.

Depending on the amount of time they remain active, there are:

- **Session cookies**, which are designed for collecting and storing data while the user accesses the website;
- **Persistent cookies**, which store data on the computer and enable said data to be accessed and processed during a given period (which can range from a few minutes to several years). The duration of said period is defined by the party responsible for the cookie.

Depending on the purpose for which the information collected by the cookies is processed, there may be:

- **Strictly necessary cookies**: which are required in order to provide a proper functioning of our website. They may, for example, control traffic and data communication, log in restricted access parts, use security features, store content to be able to disseminate videos or share content through social networks.
- **Preferences cookies**: which enable users to access the service in accordance with certain predefined characteristics, such as language, browser type, regional configuration, etc.
- **Analytical cookies**: which collect information on how the website is used, allowing us to quantify the number of users who visit our website and thus perform the measurement and statistical analysis of the use made by users of the service offered. They can also be used to quantify the impacts of the advertisements shown.
- **Marketing cookies**: which collect information on users' personal preferences and choices, which allows developing a specific profile to show advertisements based on it .

MANAGE COOKIES AND REVOKE CONSENT

You can also configure cookies and/or revoke the consent given at any time from the link available on the web.

If you accept third-party cookies and subsequently wish to delete them from your computer or mobile device, you can use the cookie deactivation tools of your browser or through the system enabled by these third parties for it through the links indicated in the section "How to delete and block/disable cookies?".

DISABLING AND DELETING COOKIES

If you do not want websites to install any cookies on your computer, you can adjust your browser settings so that you are notified before any cookies are installed. Bear in mind that if you choose not to accept cookies, we cannot guarantee that our website will work properly. Some of the website's functions may be inaccessible and your overall experience may be unsatisfactory.
